#### THE GATHERING

Four times a year, at the beginning of each new microterm, students and alumni are invited to Claremont for "the Gathering," a private networking event on Friday nights that invites you to meet faculty, staff and other students face-to-face. The Gathering also features a presentation by a dynamic thought-leader who exemplifies ethical leadership in his or her field. As a student and alumnus, you will always be welcome to drop in on the Gathering and join the conversation.

On Saturdays following the Gathering, new students will have a day-long, hands-on orientation to the program that includes introductions to the learning management system and other institutional systems and processes.

Students will also have access to a private online network—along with faculty, fellow students, and Gathering presenters—that offers support, consultation, and networking during and after the program.

#### **FORMAT**

All courses are offered entirely online through an industry standard course management system that is easy to use, educationally effective and accessible on mobile devices. This online format allows you to set your own schedule and complete assignments when it is most convenient for you.

#### COSTS

Affordably priced at \$1,500 per course, the entire program costs \$15,000, making it highly competitive with other advanced leadership programs. After you pay a \$50 application fee, you will only be responsible for the tuition for each course, the cost of books, a nominal fee to cover your graduation expenses, and a one-time trip to Claremont for the Gathering and orientation.
